

Application Checklist for Access from AT&T

If you are approved for the federal Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) and would like to apply your ACP benefit to Access from AT&T you do not need to submit an application. Please call us at 855.220.5211 (English) or 855.220.5225 (Español) to discuss your options and order service. Have your National Verifier application ID available.

To learn more and apply to the federal Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) please visit <u>affordableconnectivity.gov</u>. The federal government's National Verifier determines eligibility.

You <u>MUST</u> complete and submit an application with supporting documentation if:

- You are approved for ACP but <u>will not be applying your ACP benefit to Access from</u> <u>AT&T.</u>
 - OR
- You want to apply directly with AT&T for the Access from AT&T program <u>without</u> <u>the ACP benefit</u>.

It is important that you fill out the Access from AT&T application completely and accurately to help make sure there are no delays in being approved for the program. Please review the instructions carefully and **provide a copy of one of the documents below** as proof of eligibility.

For faster review and approval of Access from AT&T, apply and upload your documents at <u>att.com/access</u>.

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

- SNAP card, showing the name of the SNAP participant (Note: If the SNAP card does not have a name on it, you will need to provide a copy of a SNAP participation or benefits letter from the participant's local SNAP office or a copy of the front of a government ID).
- SNAP participation or benefits letter from a local SNAP office, showing the name of the SNAP participant

If the SNAP participant in your household does not have a SNAP card or benefits letter, please have the participant visit <u>http://www.fns.usda.gov/snap</u> to find your local SNAP office and obtain one.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Benefits (in California only)

- Award letter from the Social Security Administration confirming that you or a resident of your California household has qualified for and will receive SSI benefits
- Current benefits verification letter confirming that a California household resident is receiving SSI benefits

If you live in California and the SSI benefits recipient in your household does not have a copy of the original SSI award letter, please have the recipient contact the Social Security Administration Office at 800.772.1213 to obtain a copy or visit <u>https://www.ssa.gov/myaccount/proof-of-benefits.html</u> to obtain a benefit verification letter.

 Program award letter and proof of enrollment (including date, school name, school district, child's name and address)
